



# Tickets

## Film Program

To book tickets for film screenings, please follow these steps:

1. Select your screening: Go to the film you wish to attend on our website.
2. Start checkout: Proceed to the checkout page until you are requested to log in.
3. Activate your account: An account has already been created for you. Click on 'Forgot password' or 'Request new password' to set up your access.
4. Log in: Follow the instructions in your email to create a password and log in.
5. Complete your booking: Finalize the checkout. You can find your tickets under the 'My Tickets' section in your Go Short account.
6. Scan your badge: Your festival badge will have a QR-code with the tickets. You can scan the badge at the door before a screening.

## Industry Program

For our Industry events, you generally don't need a ticket. Your festival badge is sufficient. Please be aware that seats are limited and available on a first-come, first-served basis. Some sessions require prior registration. If this is the case, it will be clearly indicated in the program.

## Guest Desk

You can pick up your festival badge at the Guest Desk - see more information above.



## Q&A Protocol

Go Short aims to invite filmmakers with a film in the festival program to participate in a Q&A. The Q&A takes place in the cinema, directly after the screening of your film, with a moderator and audience participation. Your full schedule, including details about the time and location of your screening, will be sent to you by our program department. For questions, contact [program@goshort.nl](mailto:program@goshort.nl).

**We request filmmakers to be present at the screening of their film. We kindly ask you to attend your screening and arrive at the screening room 15 minutes before it starts.** At the entrance to the screening room, the room manager (a Go Short volunteer) will welcome you and introduce you to the moderator. You do not need to attend the full screening, but please inform the room manager of your plans. All Q&As are held in English. Please bring your badge, as you must show your ticket to enter the screening room.



## Photo's & Video's

During Go Short there will be pictures and videos taken. These can potentially be used for future promotion or media displays. If you do not want your picture taken please come to the Guest Desk and we will make sure your privacy is respected.

Please also be respectful when photographing and recording others.

## A Safe Environment

Please note that she is not a coach and is only available to discuss incidents that occurred during the festival. She will only contact Go Short with your consent. A follow-up procedure can be drawn up in consultation with the parties involved.


# Festival Grounds

You can relax and socialize before or after a film at the Go Short festival site. Here, you'll find the Guest Desk in the Chapel, as well as various spots for drinks and food.

You can get speciality coffee in the Chapel. On the square you can find a bar where we serve beers from local brewery De Hemel. And if you're craving a bite, you can try one of the food trucks offering, among others, freshly baked pizzas and loaded fries. Of course you can also have a drink or eat at cinema LUX, which has a terras, bar, and restaurant.

A record bus will fill the site with great music and good vibes. This year, we'll also have our own Go Short caravan on site, where you can watch short films in a cosy mini-cinema setting. The caravan also serves as an information desk. You can also find VPRO on the square.

You can dive into our VR and gaming exhibition in the large greenhouse, where you can try out cool and interactive experiences for yourself.

# Transportation

## From or to the airport

Most airports are easily reached by public transport. For Schiphol and Eindhoven, the train is the fastest option. Buy tickets online or at the station (a small surcharge applies to paper tickets). Plan your trip via the [NS journey planner](#).

Are you planning on taking a cab to the airport? The following fees are advised:

### Fees for 1 to 4 people:

Maastricht € 189,-  
Rotterdam € 189,-

### Fees for 5 to 8 people:

Schiphol € 225,-

Düsseldorf € 225,-  
Maastricht € 225,-  
Rotterdam € 225,-

Keep in mind that there is no set pricing. This is an estimate. Always discuss the standard fees with your driver.

# Transportation

## Taxi

Taxis are available at Nijmegen train station or by phone. The maximum starting fare is €4.02, plus €2.96 per kilometer and €0.49 per minute.

## Uber

Uber also works in Nijmegen, just download the app. Prices normally range from €10 to €30.

## Public Transportation

In Nijmegen city centre, the bus is the only public transport option. Pay with your bank or credit card when boarding and check out when you leave. Cash is not accepted. A day ticket (€14) is available on the bus. Plan your trip via [9292.nl](http://9292.nl) or the 9292 app.

## Parking

If you're arriving by car, use long-term parking at Wedren (Bijleveldsingel) or Oude Stad (Voorstadslaan, Hezelpoort), both within walking distance. A day ticket costs €15. Parking garages charge around €3.90 per hour.

## Bike

Cycling is the easiest way to get around Nijmegen. Some partner hotels, such as Hotel Credible, offer bike rentals. You can ask at check-in. Some homestay hosts may also have bikes available.

Basic rules:

- Use the bike lane (usually red), not the footpath
- Keep right; pass on the left
- Signal turns with your arm
- Stop at red lights; yield at the white “shark teeth” markings
- Don't use your phone while cycling (€170 fine, excl. fees)

## To Eat & Drink

### **Wakuli**

*Ziekerstraat 169*

Wakuli coffee bars serve great specialty coffee sourced directly from farmers. During Go Short 2026, they can also be found in the Mariënborg Chapel!

### **PUCK**

*Van Welderenstraat 132*

Not only do they have great coffee, the baked goods and lunch menu are fantastic. A coffee / lunch room with a great atmosphere and interior. Must visit!

### **Down Town / De tuin van Down Town**

*Kannenmarkt 16 & Lange Hezelstraat 12*

Down Town is where you can grab your coffee to go or take your time to enjoy a break with a lunch or cake in between the busy schedule. De tuin van Down Town is located in the oldest street of Nijmegen. Take a seat in their spacious backyard!

### **Bar Cali**

*Priemstraat 13*

Bar Cali is a restaurant-bar-hangout in Nijmegen's Benedenstad neighborhood. They offer a wide range of vegetarian and vegan dishes, from tasty meal platters to homemade burgers and snacks.

### **Veggie India**

*Van Wldererenstraat 97B*

A vegetarian's dream, Veggie India combines Indian cuisine with the most vibrant, fresh food possible. You can indulge in all the delicious food without any guilt or worries about the environmental impact.

### **Café de Plak**

*Bloemerstraat 90*

De Plak has been a staple in Nijmegen since the seventies. This vegetarian restaurant serves seasonal and organic dishes. A must try is “kaasgehakt”, cheese mince served with delicious hand-cut fries and lots of vegetables.
